 Jemifir's father's home + the house
 where Jemifir (Constitution signer) was
 born + grew up. This based on
 research compiled by the owner of
 the site. There are people still
 living who remember the house and
 Mr. Perrygo is making efforts to
 record their descriptions. To date it
 is believed that the house was of
 frame, probably of one story height,
 with a chimney at each end. There
 was a detached kitchen at one end
 which had a stone base chimney.
 The site is very pleasant, situated on
 a rise of land with large English
 oaks surrounding the site.

Prior to this Jemifir was believed
 to have lived at the Retreat, a nearby
 house, owned privately owned. In the
 past several years research revealed
 evidence to the contrary.

Should documentation be provided
 this could develop into a very important
 site, particularly valuable to the county
 and state. This especially in view of
 the 1976 Bicentennial celebrations.
