The Calvin C. Perdew Frame House, located in northeastern Allegany County, was built in 1910. Calvin C. Perdew, a carpenter, built the house and farmed the property for many years. The house has many interesting features. There are two irregular shaped and one diamond shaped windows on the house. Double windows on the east have a decorated mullion. The house is in original condition and is an example of the ingenuity and craftsmanship displayed by an early 20th century carpenter/farmer of eastern Allegany County.

**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Calvin C. Perdue Frame House is located on Double Pine Road north of the intersection with Old Cumberland Road.

This building consists of a "T" shaped two story, four bays wide frame structure with german siding. It rests on a low poured cement foundation with a plain water table. The gable flank roof is covered with ribbed tin with snowbirds and lightning rods. Eaves consist of a cornice, soffit, and frieze. Wall features include cornerboards. Two corbeled brick chimneys located centrally and inside end are original.

Two pedimented entrances in the center of the southern facade have original hardware. Pedimented one over one light nailed windows have wooden lugsills. The second story pediments intersect the frieze. One diamond shaped and two irregularly shaped windows are original. Double windows on the east have a decorated mullion.

A small shed roofed frame addition is on the east. A wide hip-roofed porch is on the southern facade. This porch has capped tapered square posts on wooden pedestles and two engaged chamfered posts. A shed roofed porch on the west has square wooden posts.

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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house was built just after the turn of the century in 1910.<sup>(1)</sup> It was built by Calvin C. Perdeu, a carpenter, who farmed this property for many years.

The house is still in original condition and has some interesting features. There are two irregularly shaped windows on the second story, near the roof.

This house is an example of the ingenuity and craftsmanship of an early 20th century carpenter-farmer in eastern Allegany County.
