DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame hunter's cabin is located on the north side of Oldtown Road just west of Carroll Road. It is a one story, three bay frame cabin with board and batten vertical siding. Circular saw marks are very evident on the siding.

Windows and doors are boarded shut but display architraves with molded trims. The door is partially visible and appears to have fine horizontal panels. At the front elevation the roof overhangs several feet forming a porch supported by turned posts resting a "balustrade" of vertical planks.

A central brick flue extends from the interior of the cabin.

It appears to be in fair condition.


