

AL-I-B-036 Creek Frame House

This two story frame farmhouse faces south. A modern enclosed porch covers the first story of the main facade. This porch is clad in aluminum siding. A similar enclosed porch covers the back of the house. Original German siding sheathes the rest of the building. The three bay structure rests on a stone foundation and has 2/2 sash windows.

This plain farmhouse, which appears to date from the late nineteenth century, has lost integrity of design, materials, and workmanship due to modern materials and additions. It is recommended as not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.

This two story frame building is typical of farmhouses in eastern Allegany County. Farming in this mountainous area was usually on a subsistence level due to the rugged terrain and rocky soil. The modest proportions of this building reflect the economic restrictions of farm life in the area during the nineteenth century.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Creek Frame House is located on Golden Road near Bellegrove.

This two story, three bays wide building is frame with German-siding. It rests on a low stone foundation of random rubble with a plain water table. The gable flank roof is covered with tin. Eaves consist of a cornice and fascia. Wall features include cornerboards.

The replaced main entrance is in the center of the southern facade. Pegged, two over two light windows have plain trim and wooden slipsills. Three frame additions with German siding have shed roofs. The largest of these extends across the northern flank of the house. A shed roofed front porch has plain wooden posts.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Creek Frame House is in northeastern Allegany County, near Belle Grove. It is a farmhouse that has been partially obscured by additions.

Farming has long been the only industry in this isolated northeastern area of the county. Even this occupation has been a "risky undertaking" because of the rocky terrain and soil. (1)

Although it has not retained its original appearance, Creek Frame House is a reminder of the eastern Allegany County farmers' way of life.


