The Old Post Office is a one story frame, rectangular block. The building was probably constructed by Simeon Wilson who owned one of the local general stores in the late 19th century. Originally the building was used as a warehouse for the store which is located to the west of the building. Eventually the building was to become both a general store and a Post Office.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Old Post Office and General Store is located on the south side of Main Street, Flintstone, Allegany County.

The Post Office is a rectangular block, one story tall and three bays wide. The building was originally covered with weatherboard however, at present, the building has been recovered with aluminum siding. The building rests on a low stone foundation with a plain water table. The roof is gabled, covered with tin and includes a replaced soffit. Windows are six over six lights with plain wooden, pegged sashes. The main entrance is located on the north side and features a verticle paneled door with replaced hardware.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Old Post Office and General Store was built in the 1880 decade by either John Wilson or his son Simeon Wilson. Mr. John Wilson purchased the property in 1865 from John Piper, Jr. At this time, only the house; presently the Kyle house was built on the property. The store was first built as an additional building for the commerce already located in the dwelling house. After Simeon Wilson purchased the property from his father in 1883 for \$2,000, it was simply called "Simeon Wilson's General Store." Simeon's father in deed, reserved a room in the brick dwelling for himself for his natural life. The store became a Post Office and General Store in the latter part of the century, and it is now renovated into an apartment house. ¹
