ca. 1825

The Kyle House was built in the first quarter of the 19th century by John Davis. The building was constructed of hand fired bricks and the stone foundation is forty inches thick. Windows in the house are six over six lights with louvered shutters. The building served as a general store which provided an assortment of staples, groceries, clothing and building materials for the Flintstone area. The house was also used as a tavern (its location on the Cumberland Road made it a convenient stopping place) and a post office.

**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Kyle House is located on the south side of Main Street, Flintstone, Allegany County.

The Kyle House is a two story, five bay wide, rectangular structure. At present, the house is covered with simulated brick sheeting which was placed over the original bricks. The roof is gabled with a soffit and covered with tin. The entire structure rests on a low stone foundation. Windows in the house are double hung wooden sash frames with a combination of two over two and six over six lights. All windows on the main facade have louvered shutters. Two shed roof additions are located on the south side of the building. Both are covered with aluminum siding. A five bay hipped roof end porch which is supported by Roman Doric columns covers the main entrance. The main entrance features a paneled door with a cornice and replaced hardware. Two original brick chimneys are located at the gable ends of the house.
