The Carder Log House represents one of the younger log structures in Allegany County. It was built in the late 1890's and was still considered practical during that time period, due to economy of construction. As with other log cabins built in the same general time period, the Carder house has shed roofed additions and has been covered with vertical board and batten. The majority of doors and windows have been removed; deterioration of material has set in.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Carder Log House is located 3.6 miles north of Route 51 on the Wagner Road in Oldtown, Allegany County.

The Carder House is a two story, three bay wide, rectangular building. The building is constructed of logs which have been covered with board and batten siding except for the gable ends which are covered in weatherboard. The roof is gabled and covered with tin. The majority of windows and doors have been removed, the exception being a single six over six light located on the western facade. A single replaced cement block chimney is located on the inside gable end. Two shed-roof porches have been added to the east and west facades of the house.

The Carder Log House is in deteriorated condition but retains much of its original fabric and appearance.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The log cabin remained a popular form of housing in Allegany County until the present century. They were inexpensive to build, easy to construct and extremely sturdy. In the late 1890's numerous log structures were built in the county, by its poorer inhabitants. Soon after their construction, these buildings were generally covered with board and batten.

An interesting group of these houses can be found in the Old-town area, Allegany County. The buildings are generally two stories high and two to three bays wide with several shed roofed additions to accomodate a growing family's needs. The Carder Log house is a good example of such a structure. The house was probably constructed of logs in the late 19th century and then covered with board and batten at a late date. Architecturally, it is very similar to the E.V. Sportsman's Club Log House which is located nearby.


