The E.V. Sportsman's Club House is a one and a half story saltbox. The principle facade is built of logs while the rear addition is frame. When the rear was constructed, the entire structure was covered with board and batten. The Sportsman's Club Log House is one of a group of log cabins which were built in the late 19th century by the less affluent inhabitants of the county.

 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The E.V. Sportsman's Club log house is located off Wagner Road near Oldtown, Allegany County, approximately three and a half miles north of Route 51, on the east side of the road.

The house basically consists of a one and one half story rectangular shaped block which is three bays wide. A rear, northern side addition, abuts the main block of the facade and composes a "saltbox" type of structure. The principal facade is built of logs while the rear addition is frame. The entire structure is supported by a low stone foundation with a plain water table. About the time of the construction of the rear addition, the entire block was covered with verticle boards, and battens. The roof of the structure is gabled with a shed roof on the addition and it is entirely covered by replaced tin materials. Windows in the structure are double hung wooden sash frames featuring both one over one and six over six replaced lights. The main entrance is covered by an enclosed end porch which is supported by wooden columns. One replaced, cement block chimney is included on the main block and is located on the outside eastern end.

The house is structurally sound, however it has been remodeled and is presently being used as a hunting ciub lodge.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The log cabin remained a popular form of housing in Allegany County until the present century. They were inexpensive to build, easy to construct, and extremely sturdy. In the late 1890's numerous log structures were built in the county by its poorer inhabitants. Soon after their construction these buildings were generally covered with board and batten.

An interesting group of these houses can be found in the Old-town area, Allegany County. The buildings are generally two stories high and two to three bays wide with several shed roofed additions to accomodate a growing family's needs. The E.V. Sportman's Club is a good example of such a structure. The house was probably constructed of logs in the late 19th century and then covered with board and batten at a later date. Architecturally, it is very similar to the Carder Log House which is located nearby.


