Based on the information provided by the applicant and located in the project file, the Minke Pool property does not meet the criteria for ^{individually or in a district} listing in the National Register of Historic Places. The 14.58 acre property includes a public recreation area, swimming pool, concession stand, cottage rentals, picnic pavillions, and tavern/dance hall. In the early 1930s the Minke family purchased a tract of farm/pasture land and developed and operated it as a public recreation area which came to be known as Minke's Pool. It continued to be operated by the Minke family for three decades.

The property does not appear to have the distinction required for listing under any of the applicable criteria. The buildings have been constructed over the decades of a variety of materials including log, cinderblock and frame. They exhibit no particular style and do not form a cohesive whole.

Evitts Creek Quadrangle










