<p>204 Washington Street stands on the southwest corner at the intersection of Smallwood Street in the Washington Street Historic District of Cumberland, Allegany County.</p> <p>The house is a late 1800s Colonial Revival structure of brick construction and two and a half stories. It has a hip roof with numerous gables of various sizes and a one story frame porch with plain round columns on the facade with a columned balcony above the entrance. The facade has three bay groupings with the entrance way in the middle and three sided bay windows to the west of the entrance.</p> <p>Now apartments, the building is structurally sound and basically unaltered from the original.</p>




