DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE		
<p>Located at 519 Washington Street, the house stands on the northerly side of the street, west of Allegany Street, in the Washington Street Historic District in Cumberland, Allegany County.</p> <p>The house is an 1890s Georgian or Colonial Revival style brick structure of two and a half stories with a gambrel roof, a wing (probably original) on the west side, and mid twentieth century alterations to the back (north side) for conversion to apartments. The symmetrical facade is crowned with a consoled cornice and is divided into three bays by four flat, plain pilasters with leafy capitals. The center recessed entranceway is panelled and has rectangular sidelights and rectangular transom with a fanlight tracery. The one story rectangular and semicircular porch has a dentilled cornice, a balustrade above and six free standing plain columns with volute capitals. The entranceway is flanked by three windows grouped into a set with open pediment cornices. The second story has a bay window in the center section and single windows in the side bays. The roof has two single window dormers flanking a colonnaded recessed doorway dormer. The sidelights flanking the main doorway and the upper sashes of the first floor facade windows have Gothic tracery.</p> <p>The interior was altered - partitioned added or removed, the stairway altered, and additions made to the back - when the building was converted for apartments in the mid twentieth century. The exterior of the facade appears to be in original condition.</p>

<b>STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE</b>			
<p>A photostat of the original architectural drawing for the first floor of this house indicates that it was designed by Herman Schneider, an architect, for Robert Henderson. A Colonial or Georgian Revival style structure, the house appears to have been built in the 1890s, and it is characteristic of an upper class residence of the close of the nineteenth century. Henderson, an attorney, is said to have married the daughter of the man who occupied the house to the east, 515 Washington Street, now the Women's Civic Club.</p> <p><u>Note:</u> The photostat referred to here is in the possession of the present owner. It gives no date or indication of where Schneider had an office.</p>


