<p>Located at 14-20 South Mechanic Street, the building stands on the easterly side of the street in the block formed by Baltimore and Pershing Streets in Cumberland, Allegany County.</p> <p>The structure is a mid nineteenth century three story brick double building with modern shop fronts at street level and a new brick facing above. It has four along the street and parapets at the end walls and the common wall. All the upper level windows of the facade (west side) have double-hung wooden sashes with one-over-one lights except for the two on the third story of the north side which have six-over-one sashes.</p> <p>The building appears to be structurally sound.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The double building at 14-20 South Mechanic Street is important as representing a mid nineteenth century form of architecture found commonly in Cumberland. Probably erected as a double house, the building has undergone major alteration through the addition of modern shop fronts on the ground level and a refacing with brick of the upper stories.

A photograph of downtown Cumberland in the late nineteenth century, published in Art Work of Allegany County (1897), shows this building as having tall windows and an iron balcony the length of the facade on the second story.


