<p>36 North Mechanic Street stands on the westerly side of the street along Wills Creek, in the block formed by Baltimore and Frederick Streets in the central business district of Cumberland, Allegany County.</p> <p>The building is a two story brick structure with a modern commercial front on the ground level.</p> <p>The building is a two story brick structure with a stone arch window arrangement on the second story of the facade (east side) and a recent commercial front below a dentilled and bracketed cornice. The arch window is flanked by two large rectangular windows. The facade is crowned by a bracketed and dentilled cornice which is a large version of the one above the shop front. The building extends above the cornice in the affect of a roof balistrade. Recently renovated, the structure is sound.</p>


