DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>Located at 122 Bedford Street, the building stands on the northerly side of the street east of South Centre Street in Cumberland, Allegany County.</p> <p>"Bedford" is a mid nineteenth century three story brick house with a brick cornice and three bays across the facade. (south side) The house sets tight to the side walk and has a cut stone foundation along the street. The end walls extend above the roof forming parapets with double chimneys in the west wall. The main entrance is in the east bay of the facade and has a heavy, curved hood. Each of the facade windows has a heavy lintel, double-hung, wooden sashes with six-over-one lights. The window lintels, sashes, and the door hood date probably from the early 1900's. The bond of the brick on the facade is stretcher and that of the side walls is Common (6 stretchers to 1 header).</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE <p style="margin-left: 40px;">122 Bedford Street is representative of mid nineteenth century domestic architecture in Cumberland. The building shows a strong influence of the Greek style in the plain facade with the symmetrically arranged openings. The building, known as the "Bedford", was converted for apartment in recent years.</p>


