<p>The building is located on the southerly side of Bedford Street just east of South Centre Street in Cumberland, Allegany County.</p> <p>The building is a two and a half story brick structure with a recessed entranceway, a bay window on the second floor, and a cornice with small brackets. The entranceway is arched with rusticated stone work as are the lintels of the principal windows. The first floor has a group of three windows. In addition to the three windows in the bay, the second floor has two small windows grouped above the entrance. The roof is shingled with slate. The exterior is painted in tones of gray. The bond of the brick on the facade is stretcher.</p>


