DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>119 Bedford Street stands on the southerly side of the street east of the intersection of South Centre Street in Cumberland, Allegany County.</p> <p>The building is a mid nineteenth century brick structure, two and a half stories high, with a stone foundation and three bays along the principal facade (north side). The west end wall extends above the roof forming a parapet and contains double interior chimneys. The principal windows have brick flat arches and double-hung wooden sashes with one-over-one lights. The front entrance, reached by three masonry steps, is located in the north bay of the street facade. The roof is covered with tin. A wing with a side porch and balcony is attached to the back (south side). The brick bonding of the facade is stretcher and that of the sides common (9 stretchers to 1 header).</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE <p style="margin-left: 40px;">119 Bedford Street is representative of mid nineteenth century "lower-middle class" classical influenced domestic architecture in Cumberland. The design shows little aesthetic striving but is fairly symmetrical in the arrangement of the facade openings and the principal rooms on the main floor. It is the type of house that was being built in the area about the 1840s and 1850s.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">The building is scheduled for demolition in conjunction with the Bedford Street bridge project over the railroad tracks to the east.</p>


