DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>Located in the Washington Street Historic District in Cumberland, Allegany, 535 Washington Street stands on the north side of the street along the east side of North Brook Avenue.</p> <p>The house basically consists of two rectangular blocks of two stories that abut each other. The eastern portion, the principal facade (east side), has the second story under a mansard roof, steep pitch wall dormers, a small entrance tower, an oriental influenced one story porch, and a bracketed cornice. The western portion has a flat roof and a very strong Italianate influence. It is essentially the back of the house which faces east. Both portions are said to have been erected at the same time although the odd union, the roof lines, the window treatment, and different types of brackets indicate that the west half probably predates the other.</p> <p>For additional descriptive material, see Sangiovanini paper on file at Maryland Historical Trust in Annapolis.</p>

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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE <p>535 Washington Street, a Mansard influenced house, is said to have been erected 1872-1873 as the residence of Ferdinand Williams, an attorney. The property is a part of the Rose Hill Estate that was acquired by David Lynn in the late 1780s. The present owners purchased the house in 1947. The difference in the window treatment, roof lines, and cornice brackets indicate that the western half was probably built before the east half, now the principal facade.</p>


