DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

80-84 Baltimore Street stands on the northerly side of the street between Liberty and Centre Streets in the central business district in Cumberland, Allegany County.

The building is a three story gray brick structure with white glazed brick trim. The street level has two modern shop fronts. Above the western half, number 84, the remains of the original entablature with a triglyph and the number 84 carved into the stone exist. The shop fronts have a fluted cornice with egg-and-dart-like molding. The second and third stories have two sets of windows -- those of the upper level are arched -- forming arcades. The second story windows are double-hung wooden sashes with one-over-one lights. The third story openings have round top double-hung wooden sashes, one-over-one lights, surrounded by a series of smaller lights. Belt courses stretch across the facade at the base of the second story windows and at the beginning of the arches of the third story windows. The arches have ornamental surrounds with scroll keystones. A bracketed cornice of glazed brick is surmounted by a closed balustrade with a swags and wreath base relief sculpture in the middle flanked by column-like end pieces.

The upper levels of the facade appear to be in fairly original condition.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

80-84 Baltimore Street is representative of late nineteenth century commercial architecture in Cumberland. The facade shows the eclectic influence of the Romanesque style in the arcaded window arrangement and the classical manner in the decorative treatment. The Cumberland area had several brick factories at the turn of the century and the execution of this building is a tribute to this local industry.


