STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			
<p>The building at 57-59 Baltimore Street is an example of mid twentieth century commercial architecture. It blends in the rhythm of lines of other buildings along Baltimore Street but its plain design stands in contrast with the ornamented late nineteenth and early twentieth century structures that neighbor it.</p>


