DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>Located at 110-112 Greene Street in Cumberland, Allegany County, the building stands on the southerly side of the street between Johnson Street and Winton Place to the west of Wills Creek.</p> <p>The building is a two and a half story brick semi-detached double house with double internal end chimneys on the east and west gable walls. The gable walls extend above the roof forming parapets. A brick cornice runs across the principal facade (north side). The first floor of the street facade has large show windows and entranceways of twentieth century vintage. The upper level has six bays, three on each side, with double-hung wooden sashes with one-over-one lights, brick flat arches, and wooden sills. The brick of the facade is laid in Flemish bond and that of the side walls in Common bond (5 stretcher, 1 header).</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE <p>The house at 110-112 Greene Street is representative of the classically influenced middle class domestic architecture of the mid nineteenth century in Cumberland. Rows of houses of this type with symmetrical facades in detached and semi-detached, double form with parapet or step end gables were being constructed in the city in the 1830s - 1850s period. Few of the houses remain in original condition. Most of the houses were altered with the change of styles and/or use of the building as is evident here.</p>




