DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Located in Cumberland at 71 Greene Street, the building stands on the northerly side of the street to the east of the intersection of Johnson Street.

The building is a three story Greek Revival style brick house with an end wall plan two rooms deep, a low pitch roof, double internal end chimneys and parapets on gable end walls. The principal facade (south side) was covered in recent years with artificial brick and stone but still retains its original symmetrical arrangement of three bays and brick cornice. The main entranceway, possibly original, in the east bay, is framed with flat pilasters, entablature and pediment above. The present door, not original, has a large window above two small panels and a transom above. The windows of the first and second floor are double-hung wooden sashes with one-over-one lights. The third floor windows are double-hung wooden sashes with three-over-three lights. A door was cut into the west bay of the street level.

Although altered, the building retains enough original fabric on the exterior to make restoration possible and hopeful. The building appears to be structurally sound.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE <div style="padding: 10px;"> <p>71 Greene Street is important architecturally for representing the strong influence that the Greek Revival style had on mid nineteenth century house construction in Cumberland and Allegany County. Erected probably in the 1840s or 1850s, the house appears to have been a stylish residence of its time.</p> </div>




