The Pope Log House, which has been drastically altered from original appearance, was built by the Consolidation Coal Company for the purpose of supplying miners with inexpensive and adequate housing. The structure is one and one half stories high, three bays wide and is constructed of logs. An exterior covering, including aluminum siding and shutters, has been added recently. A small one story wing abuts the main block on the east side and a shed wing is found on the rear south side. The house exhibits double hung wooden sash frames with one-over-one light windows and plain trim on all features.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Pape old log house is located along old Route 40 in Eckhart, Allegany County on the south side of the road near the intersection of Main Street.

The house consists of a one and a half story, three bay wide square shaped facade. A small wing abuts the main block on the eastern side and is only one story high. The building originally was a log structure which was supported by a low stone foundation; however the logs have since been covered with aluminum siding. The roof of the house is gabled and is covered with replaced asphalt shingles. Windows in the structure include double hung wooden sash frames with one-over-one lights and decorative shutters on the front and sides. The main entrance is placed on the front, northern face and features a replaced, verticle paneled door with plain trim. A three bay end porch is covering the entrance and features a shed roof supported by iron rod railing. The porch is a replaced addition, as evidenced by the cement block foundation. Two corbeled brick chimneys, which appear to be original are located centrally and in the interior of the structure.

The log house is structurally sound, but the original appearance has been somewhat altered by the aluminum covering and the porch addition.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Pape old log house was built between 1830 and 1850 by the Consolidation Coal Company. The structure was built by the company in order to supply mine workers with a means of inexpensive and adequate housing. Many company houses were built in the Eckhart mining community when the mines were very prosperous, and most of these are still standing. A variety of materials were used in the construction of these houses, and examples of each are given with this survey. The house's good condition certainly enhances the cultural mining heritage of Allegany County.




