This 1 1/2-story log house with frame additions has fallen into ruin. The three-bay structure was built in the late 19th century. A small frame outbuilding, a frame wagon barn, and an underground stone storage "cave" were also located on the property. As this structure is no longer standing the site is recommended as not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.

Brode Log House

Brode Log House is the only surviving structure of a group of company-owned houses located on a hillside near Hoffman Mines known to local residents as "Pig Toe Hill." Occupants of the houses were employees of a mining company operating in nearby "Pompey Smash", now known as Vale Summit. This dwelling was purchased by Phillip F. Brode, Sr., who purchased the property from the Consolidation Coal Company in 1929. It is typical of log houses of Allegany County, being one and one-half stories tall and three bays wide and resting on a random rubble stone foundation.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This building is a one and one-half story, three bays wide rectangular log structure covered with insulbrick siding. It rests on a low foundation of random rubble stone with corrugated tin. Eaves consist of a cornice, bedmould and simple brackets on the gabled ends and of rafter ends on the flanks. A replaced brick chimney with a corbeled cap is located inside end.

A replaced five light door is in the center of the northern facade. Sash windows include original pegged six over six lights and replaced two over two lights and one six over one light window. Casement windows are of six and four lights. A shed roofed porch with wooden posts is on the north. Shed roofed frame additions resting on wooden posts telescope on the east.

On the southern side of the building is an ice or spring house constructed of stone piled on a bank. A smaller out buildings include a small gabled building and a large wagon barn built on vertical log beams.

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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Brode Log House is the only surviving structure of a group of company-owned houses located on a hillside near Hoffman Mines known to local residents as "Pig Toe Hill." (1) Occupants of the houses were employees of a mining company operating in nearby "Pompey Smash", now known as Vale Summit. (2) Oral informants state that the group of houses predates 1895 when James Piper was born on "Pig Toe Hill."(3)

This particular dwelling was the "homeplace" of Phillip F. Brode, Sr. who purchased the property from the Consolidation Coal Company in 1929.(4) It is typical of log houses of Allegany County, being one and one-half stories tall and three bays wide and resting on a random rubble stone foundation. Original windows are six over six light pegged sashes. A stone "cave, used for storage" is built into the hillside directly behind the log house. (5)





