This two-story frame house stands just south of the main residential street in AL-V-A-285, Hoffman Hollow Survey District. The five-bay dwelling slopes down to one story at the rear forming a saltbox profile. A one-story porch spans the main south facade. A concrete block foundation underpins the porch and plain horizontal boards form the balustrade. The house has a central entrance and 2/2 sash windows. The building stands on a stone foundation. An exterior concrete block furnace flue is located at the west end.

This property is not a significant example of its type and therefore it is recommended as not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.
