DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Brailier Mining Company House is located to the east of Bald Knob Road near Mount Savage. The rectangular dwelling is two stories tall and three bays wide on the northeastern facade. A one-story frame addition with a gabled roof abuts the southwestern elevation of the house. Wall construction is frame with german siding covered with insul brick siding. The gabled roof is covered with asphalt shingles. Eaves consist of a boxed cornice and soffit. Wooden posts which originally supported the dwelling were replaced with a high foundation of rusticated cement blocks in the 1920's.

Shed roofed porches on the facade and the southwestern elevation are not original. Original 2/2 sashes have been replaced with modern 1/1 sashes. The main entrance is offset on the facade and includes a nine light door. An added brick chimney is located on the exterior of the southeastern elevation.

A small board and batten barn northeast of the dwelling has a gabled roof covered with asphalt shingles. The barn rests on wooden posts. To the east of the dwelling is the site of a schoolhouse which has been removed.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Brailer Mining Company House was built early in the 20th century by the Brailer Mining Company. (Bittner interview) In 1903-1904 the company, which was then known as the George's Creek and Bald Knob Coal Company, opened the Bald Knob Mine on property of the Brailer family north of Mount Savage. In 1918 " an average of 45 miners and 9 laborers were employed..." at the mine. (Carney interview and Coals of Maryland, pp. 162-163) The small frame house is typical of houses built in Allegany County around the turn of the century. A small board and batten barn and the site of a schoolhouse are also located on the property. (Bittner Interview)


