<p>The house stands at 200 National Highway, U.S. Route 40, on the southwest corner of the intersection of Park Avenue in the area known as LaVale, west of Cumberland, Allegany County, Maryland.</p> <p>The house is a two and a half story brick structure in the Queen Anne style. It has a slate covered hip roof with a fish scale pattern worked into the shingles, a three story circular tower on the facade (northeast corner), a one story porch on the facade and easterly side, a large front dormer with a jerkin-head roof, and large windows. The tower is brick on the first two levels and frame above. The porch posts, no balustrade, are brick at the bottoms and frame in the upper halves. The upper sections of the porch posts, the top section of the tower, and the gable ends are covered with stucco.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			
<p>The house that stands at 200 National Highway in LaVale, Allegany County, is important as an example of a late phase of the Queen Anne style of architecture. Although the exact date of construction is unknown, the house appears to have been erected about the first decade of the twentieth century. This approximate date is based upon the stylistic features - stucco applied over frame construction, the windows and doors - that are similar to those found on other early twentieth century houses in the area. The building is in a near original condition on the exterior and stands as a cultural document of a way of life once found in Allegany County.</p>




