The Schellhaus Farmhouse has the distinction of being one of three brick buildings in Allegany County constructed using Flemish bond. The original facade consists of a two story, three bay wide, "L" shaped structure; however, a large frame addition now abuts the main block on the south side. In all probability the house was constructed during the first quarter of the 19th century by Henry Porter, a member of one of the founding families of Mt. Savage.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Schellhaus Farm is located at the end of Weimer Road near Mt. Savage, Allegany County.

The house consists of two sections that were constructed at different times. The original facade consists of a two story, three bay wide, "L" shaped structure. This original block is constructed of brick laid in Flemish bond and is supported by a Flemish bond foundation. A two story wing forms the "L" of the structure, and a recent frame addition abuts the original block at the apex of the "L". The addition consists of a two and a half story, three bay wide, rectangular structure covered with weatherboarding and aluminum siding. The addition is supported by a low stone foundation. The roof of the entire structure is gabled. The ridges of the main block and rear addition run parallel and the entire roof is covered with replaced asphalt shingles. The eaves of the structure feature close verges and fascia while the frame addition exhibits boxed cornices. Windows in the house include double hung wooden sash frames with six-over-six lights, jack arches and louvered shutters. Featured on the first story level are French windows with eight lights and louvered shutters, and these are located on the front and east side. The main entrance is located on the front northern side and features replaced French doors with jack arch and plain trim. A full height portico is placed on the front northern face. The portico exhibits a banistered flat roof and entablature supported by square, full length columns. A one story, hipped porch covers an entrance on the west side. Two replaced brick chimneys are located to the interior of the facade.

Also found on the farm property is a recently constructed barn. The barn is built of verticle boards supported by a stone foundation and is covered by a gambrel roof.

The farm is structurally sound but has been drastically altered since original construction.

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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Schellhaus Farmhouse has the distinction of being one of two brick buildings in Allegany County constructed using Flemish bond. The present owners purchased the property in 1954 and have altered it significantly since that time. Thus, the building which was once a simple two story, three bay wide "L" shaped farmhouse, now has a large frame addition on the southeast side while the main facade is dominated by a two story Mt. Vernon - type portico.

In all probability the house was constructed during the first quarter of the 19th century by Henry Porter. Porter was one of a group of Catholic settlers who migrated to the Mt. Savage area at the close of the French and Indian War. ¹
