DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Hemming Log Cabin is located on the Cash Valley Road near Corriganville, Allegany County.

The building basically consists of a two and one-half story, three bay wide, rectangular shaped log structure. Wall construction is mud and wood chinking. Also the sides are partly covered with clapboard. Wall features are plain. The building is supported by a high, stone foundation and includes a plain water table. The roof of the building is gable flank covered with tin; replaced. Eaves of the roof exhibit a wide soffit. Windows in the building are pegged, double hung, with wooden sash frames and three-over-one and six-over-six lights. Window trim is plain with some wooden slipsills. The one chimney in the building is replaced; made of cement block and located inside end. The main entrance is located on the southeast facade and once had a hood made of tin hanging over it. Hardware is replaced.

The building is still structurally sound but in poor condition with only some of its original appearance to be seen.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Hemming Log Cabin on Cash Valley Road was constructed in the 1840's with mud and wood chinking. In all probability this now vacant building was originally a farmer's house.

Log construction was the most economic building material available to early settlers in this region. Abundant forests provided the cheapest and structurally functional mode of housing for most of the less - affluent settlers in the area .

All of the original hardware, including the chimney has been replaced. The sides have been covered with clapboard and only the front and back retain any reminder of the original appearance of the cabin. Being in progressively poorer condition the cabin serves as a symbol of the early farmer's cultural awareness and relationship with the environment


