Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

Small Structure No. 01204X0 is a rumble stone arch on US 40 Alt and that carries a branch of Braddock Run. The date of construction is not known, however, it was probably built in the early 1800's when the National Road was constructed. Small Structure No. 01204X0 was extended on the north side with a 5 feet by 5 feet modern concrete box culvert.


Although altered, Small Structure No. 01204X0 is significant for its method of construction. It is one of a limited number of surviving pre-1850 stone arch culverts associated with the National Road, the first federally funded road. According to the Small Structures on Maryland's Roadways Historic Context Report, stone arches along the National Road are eligible for the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) if at least one side of the stone arch is exposed. Therefore, Small Structure No. 01204X0 is eligible for the NRHP under Criterion A and C.). The property is not known to be associated with the lives of persons significant in the local, state, or national past (criterion B). The property is not being evaluated under criterion D.
