Based on available information the structure at 12013 Kite Ave., Cumberland, Md., is not located within the boundaries of a state listed historic district and does not meet the criteria for individual listing on the Maryland Register under Criterion C. The house does not appear to possess any particular architectural significance. It is a modest, two story side-gabled cottage with a large centered dormer at the second level. The type is found throughout the state and was probably built in the late teens or early 1920's. The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past, and thus does not qualify under Criteria A or B.


