Based on the available information, the house at 12901 McMullen Highway does not appear to meet the National Register criteria for individual listing. The modest bungalow style house probably dates to the first quarter of the 20th century and is a relatively intact example of an extremely common early 20th century house type. However, it does not appear to have any particular architectural significance. It is not known to have been associated with any significant people or events. Lastly, while it is situated in a row of three similar bungalow type houses, the other houses in the area appear to date to c. 1960. Thus, 12901 McMullen does not appear to be located in a National Register eligible historic district.


