DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>The house stands to the west of the present Maryland Route 36, below U.S. Route 48, south of Frostburg, Allegany County, at the entrance to the Sanitation Land Fill, No. 1.</p> <p>The house, in ruinous condition, is an early nineteenth century Federal style brick structure, two and a half stories high with a lower two and a half stories high wing on the south end. Both sections have gable roofs and brick cornices. The main section has three bays on the facade with the door in the southern bay. The windows and door have narrow frames. The doorway has a fan light and the windows have flat brick arches. Few of the windows remain but indications are that the first floor had double-hung wooden sashes with six-over-nine lights. The bricks of the facade are laid in Flemish bond and those of the sides in Common bond. The front porch, not original, that is shown on the enclosed photographs collapsed in recent months.</p> <p>The interior, now in shambles, had Neo-Classical trim, six panel doors, Adamesque ovals (fluted and plain), columns, and a urn sculpture above the one door in the hall.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Probably one of the most stylish houses of its time in Allegany County, this house appears to have been built about the 1820s. Few other houses in the county have woodwork to rival what this house had. The house believed to have been built for a Christopher Seymore was abandoned quite some time ago and, unfortunately, has been vandalized to the point that its character has been ruined.


