DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Consolidation Coal Company House is located on the east side of Route 36 near Carlos Junction, Allegany County.

The Consolidation Coal Company House is a two story, three bay wide, "T" shaped structure that has recently been covered with vinyl siding. The entire structure rests on a low stone foundation. The roof is gabled with a soffit and is covered with both slate and asphalt shingles. Windows in the house have been replaced and are double hung wooden sash frames with a combination of one over one and two over two lights. The main entrance is located on the west facade and features a vertically paneled door with replaced hardware. The entrance is covered by a three bay end porch with a shed roof. Two corbeled brick chimneys are located in the interior of the building.

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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Hanlin House was built by the Consolidation Coal Company in the second half of the 19th century and was reputedly used to house the mine superintendent for the National Mine or Mine #10. Although the house was built of logs it is more substantial than the dwellings constructed for the miners themselves.

The Consolidation Coal Company was established in 1864 and eventually became one of the largest bituminous coal companies in the United States.¹ In 1871, the company owned 311 dwelling houses, and in 1873, it listed among its assets dwellings at the mines worth \$115,045.²
