DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The First National Bank is located at the intersection of Broadway and Chesnut Streets in Midland, Allegany County.

The First National Bank is a narrow, rectangular, brick block that is two stories high and one bay wide. Two frame additions that have been covered with aluminum siding abuts the main block on the north-west of the building. The building rests on a low brick foundation and is constructed of brick laid in a combination of "stretcher" course on the main facade and American Common Bond on the northeast and southwest sides. The bank has a shed roof that has been covered with asphalt shingles. A belt course of rock-faced sandstone separates the first and second stories on the main facade. Windows in the main block exclusive of the main facade are double hung, wooden sash frames with one over one lights and semi-circular arches and a partial hoodmold. Windows on the main facade differ slightly. Those on the second floor are arched with one over one lights with semi-circular arches. A large arched window is also located on the first floor. The main entrance is located on the southeast facade and is topped by a fanlight that is boarded up and by a rock faced lintel. Two original, corbeled brick chimneys are located at the flush end of the building.

The Midland Bank is in fair condition and although the building has been altered somewhat since, it is now used as a private residence, it retains much of its original character and appearance.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The First National Bank opened in 1902, the same year that the town of Midland was incorporated. The bank served the community until 1933 at which time it was forced to close.

Although the bank is presently used as a private residence, it nevertheless remains as a good example of the Romanesque style as it was used for a commercial building.
