DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Spiker Log House is located on the north side of Buskirk Hollow Road in Gilmore, Allegany County.

The Spiker House is a two story, three bay wide, rectangular log structure that has been covered in places with a variety of verticle boards. The hand hewn logs are laid with "V" notching and the chinking is a combination of cement and the original mud and pebbles. The building is supported by a low stone foundation with a plain water table. A single story shed-roofed addition is located on the north side of the building. Windows in the structure are double hung wooden sash frames with two over two lights. The main entrance is located on the building's southern facade and both the door and the hardware have been replaced. The entrance is covered by a crudely constructed three bay end porch with a sagging shed roof. A single, replaced brick chimney is located in the interior of the building.

Although the Spiker House is in deteriorated condition, it nevertheless retains some of its original fabric and appearance.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Lob Cabin remained a popular form of housing in Allegany County until the present century. They were inexpensive to build, easy to construct and extremely sturdy. In the late 19th century numerous log structures were built in Allegany County. Soon after construction, these buildings were generally covered with board and batten. Although it is in deteriorated condition, the Spiker House is a good example of such a structure. The house was constructed in the late 19th century and covered with board and batten at a later date.
