DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

St. Mary's School is located just east of St. Mary's Church on St. Mary's Terrace in Lonaconing, Allegany County.

St. Mary's School building is a two and a half story, three bay wide frame structure that has been covered with novelty siding. The roof is gabled with a wide soffit and has been covered with tin. Windows in the structure are double hung, wooden sash frames with two over two lights. Originally all the windows had cornices; however, these have been removed in favor of plain trim. The entire building rests on a low stone foundation. A small, single story, shed-roofed addition is located on the east side of the building. The main entrance is located on the west side of the building. Originally, it featured a vertically paneled door with a wide transom light and a hood on brackets. At present; however, the door is covered by a three bay enclosed entrance porch with a flat roof. A single, corbeled, brick chimney is located at the inside gable end.




