The Farm Site is located to the west of Legislative Road approximately one-half of a mile north of Woodland. The site includes the ruins of a log barn, a small frame barn, a stone springhouse, and the site of a farmhouse. A modern sawmill is located to the north of the farm.

The Farm Site includes outbuildings which are representative of both early and late nineteenth century rural construction.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The farm site is located to the west of Legislative Road approximately one-half of a mile north of Woodland. The site includes the ruins of a log barn, a small frame barn, a stone springhouse, and the site of a farmhouse. A modern saw mill is located to the north of the farm.

The double pen log barn is in ruinous condition. Walls of the barn are of "V" notched logs. A forebay on the eastern elevation of the barn has collapsed. The barn rests on stone pillars, located at the corners of the structure.

The small frame barn is covered with vertical boards. It rests on a foundation of poured cement. The gabled roof is covered with tarpaper.

The springhouse has walls of random ashlar stone. The gabled roof is covered with corrugated metal. The face of the gabled roof is covered with vertical boards. An opening is located in the center of the southern elevation of the springhouse. A small frame structure, probably a pump housing, abuts the southern elevation of the springhouse. The springhouse is partially buried in a mound of sawdust.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The farm site includes outbuildings which are representative of both early and late nineteenth century rural construction. A double pen log barn and a stone springhouse were probably built during the first half of the nineteenth century. A frame barn covered with vertical boards is a typical late nineteenth century outbuilding.


