DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The McFarlane Houses are located on the eastern side of Legislative Road at Knapp's Meadows. The buildings were built on sloping ground and have fully exposed foundations on the southern elevations. The rectangular dwellings are two and one-half stories tall, four bays wide on the facades (western elevations) and four bays deep. The second story facade of the upper house is two bays wide. The second story facade of the lower house is four bays wide.

The frame buildings are covered with insul brick siding. They rest on high ashlar stone foundations. The gabled roofs are covered with tarpaper. The upper house has a hip roofed porch on the facade which has turned posts and a lattice-like base. The lower house has an unusual shed-roofed veranda on the facade and southern elevation which has turned posts with decorative bracketing. On the southwestern corner of the porch there is an entrance portal with a triangular pediment and a gabled roof. Both houses have shed roofed porches on the eastern elevations. Windows of the houses are 2/2 sash. Two entrances in the center of the facade of the upper house and two entrances on the ends of the facade of the lower house had transoms which have been enclosed. Three brick chimneys are located on the interior of each of the houses.
