

Hyde Frame House

The Hyde Frame House is located on Temperance Row in Barton. Charles C. Patterson purchased lot #59 of Barton in 1894. He built this house in 1896 when tax assessments show an improvement on the property of \$500.00

The house is a two story, three bays wide frame structure with weatherboard siding. Two brick chimneys are located in the center of the main block, one inside end brick chimney is located on the addition. A porch on the north has a steeply pitched hip roof supported by four square posts and two engaged pilasters.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Hyde Frame House is located on the southern side of Temperance Row in Barton.

The house is a two story, three bays wide frame structure with weatherboard siding. It rests on a low stone foundation of random rubble with a plain water table. The building originally consisted of a rectangular block, a gabled frame addition on the south makes the building an "L". A gabled addition extending from the addition has been removed. The gable flank roof is covered with tar paper. Eaves consist of a boxed cornice, soffit, bed moulding, frieze, and returns. Two brick chimneys are located in the center of the main block, one inside end brick chimney is located on the addition.

The main entrance in the center of the northern facade consists of a two panel, one light door with original hardware. Windows are pegged six over six light sashes with wooden slipsills. A porch on the north has a steeply pitched hip roof supported by four square posts and two engaged pilasters.







Sanborn Map, 1921-1936


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
