DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Beener House is located at the eastern end of Bartlett Cemetery near Moscow. The frame, two-story, three bay by one bay house is based on the ell-plan. The facade faces southeast. A two-story frame addition abuts the northwest elevation of the ell.

The framehouse is covered with weatherboards and asbestos shingle siding. It rests on a high random ashlar stone foundation. The hipped roof is covered with asphalt shingles. A hip roofed porch on the facade has turned posts with decoratively scrolled brackets. Other decorative elements of the porch include jigsawn gingerbread along the roof line and a jigsawn slatboard balustrade. Windows of the first floor on the facade and southwestern elevation are tall and pegged 2/2 sash. Other windows are 1/1 sash. An entrance in the center of the facade includes a two light transom and a door of one light with five rectangular panels below it and three square panels above. An entrance on the northeastern elevation is sheltered by a simply bracketed hipped hood and has a door of twelve lights and one panel. An exterior cinderblock chimney is on the southwestern elevation.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

 The Beener House is typical of houses built during the late nineteenth century or early in the twentieth century.in western Allegany County. The "L" shaped house has been altered by the construction of a two-story addition which abuts the northwestern elevation. The facade, and especially a hip roofed porch with bracketed posts and gingerbread ornamentation, is in relatively original condition.


