## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house is situated in a hilly, semi-wooded area on Mill Run Rd. approximately 1/8 mile west of Rt. 36. The house faces east. It is a two story, three bay by one bay gable roof structure with a one bay by one bay ell. A two story shed roof addition is located at ~~the~~ south elevation of the ell. A single story shed roof addition is located along the rear, west, elevation of both the ell and the two story addition. A wooden porch supported by turned posts with plain balustrades covers the facade bays. The facade entrance is located slightly to the west end. The house can also be entered from the rear shed addition.

The house has a central brick chimney where the main block meets the ell. Two over two sash windows, framed with plain flat boards, light the house. The house rests on a stone foundation. Asphalt shingles cover the exterior with asphalt shingles on the roof as well.


