DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house is situated in a hilly, semi-wooded area on Laurel Run Rd. approximately 3/4 miles northwest of Rt. 36. The house faces north. It is a two story, four bay by one gable roof structure with a two story shed roof addition that extends the length of the rear, south, elevation. A single story gable roof addition is located at the southwest corner. A wooden hip roof porch supported by slightly tapered wood posts covers the facade. The house has two entrances, one at each end of the facade. An exterior cinderblock chimney is located at the center of the rear, south elevation. An interior brick chimney is located at the southeast corner of the gable roof addition. One over one sash windows with plain drip cap molding light the house. Six over six sash windows are located at the rear elevation and on the gable roof addition. The house rests on a stone foundation. Narrow weatherboard siding framed with cornerboards covers the house. Tar paper covers the roof.


