**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This frame house is situated in a hilly, semi-wooded area on Stoney Run Rd. approximately ½ mile from Rt. 36. The house faces west. The house is in two sections. The first section is a single story, two bay by one bay structure with a gable roof. The second section is a story and a half, one by deep gable roof structure located at the north elevation of the first section. A wooden flat roof porch supported by turned posts covers the facade from the south end nearly to the north. A wooden, shed roof porch supported by turned posts with jig-sawn balustrades is located at the rear, east, elevation is located at the north end of the first section where it meets the second, story and a half section. An entrance is also located at the rear porch.

Two over two sash windows, with drip cap window heads, light the house. A single pane window is located in the gable end of the single story section. Two pane windows are located in the half story of the second section. German siding covers the second section and weatherboards cover the first with tarpaper on the roofs.


