The single-family dwelling at 213 ~~Smott~~^{Smoot} Street in Westernport, Allegany County, is located outside the boundaries of the identified National Register-eligible historic districts in Westernport and is not considered individually eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The dwelling is a two-story, two-bay, side-passage frame dwelling covered with a hipped roof. It is raised upon an elevated foundation level and features a full-width front porch. Probably built in the second decade of this century, the house is representative of domestic house forms from the period and lacks the architectural distinctiveness necessary to qualify if for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. The property is not known to have associations with persons or events significant to our past.






