DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>171 East Main Street in Frostburg, Allegany County, stands on the north side of the street at the intersection of Bowery Street, south east corner.</p> <p>The house is a mid nineteenth century Greek Revival brick structure of three stories with a stone foundation, a low gable roof with single end chimneys, a symmetrical facade (north side) of three bays with a columned recessed entranceway and a dentilled cornice. The bricks of the facade are laid in Flemish bond and those of the sides in Common bond. The principal windows have flat brick arches and narrow frames with double-hung wooden sashes with six-over-six lights. The third floor windows are small and have wooden frame casement sashes. The recessed entranceway, in the east bay, has a pilastered entablature frame with two free standing fluted columns. The door, not original, is surrounded by rectangular sidelights and transom. The three part transom has a criss-cross pattern tracery.</p> <p>The building is structurally sound but in need of repair. The facade is basically unaltered but the sides and interior show signs of alteration.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

171 East Main Street is the finest Greek Revival style house in Frostburg, Allegany County. It has the characteristic low third story and the concentration of decorative detailing at the main entranceway. Although the interior has been altered for apartments and offices and the sides of the exterior show signs of change, the principal facade (north side) is basically unaltered, making restoration both hopeful and feasible.

Tradition says the house was built for the McCulloch family. It was probably erected after 1858 when Robert McCulloch purchased a lot described as a part of the tract known as "The Hotel" from Mary McCulloch. (Deed Book 16, p. 635.) Stylistically, the house is typical of other 1850s buildings in Allegany County.

The present owners acquired the property in 1971.



