The houses along Bowery Street, as shown in the photographs the City provided, can be characterized as late nineteenth to early twentieth century buildings whose integrity has been compromised through the construction of unsympathetic additions and the application of vinyl siding. The Frostburg Historic District (MIHP #AL-VII-A-43) is listed in the National Register of Historic Places. One block of Bowery Street is within the boundaries of the District at the north end between U.S. 40 and East Mechanic Street. However, the majority of the project lies outside the National Register district boundaries. The National Register form for the Historic District excluded Bowery Street south of Mechanic Street, and it appears that the buildings lack the architectural distinction and qualities which characterize the District as a whole. Therefore, Bowery Street is not eligible for inclusion in the National Register either individually or as a contributing portion of the Frostburg Historic District.


