The house at 116 Frost Avenue in Frostburg, Allegany County, MD is located outside of the Frostburg Historic District and is not individually eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The building is a two-story, gable-fronted frame dwelling with a side entry door. Probably built in the first quarter of this century, the dwelling follows a relatively common mid-to late 19th-century dwelling form that was popularized in the early 20th-century Colonial Revival period. The house is a representative example of its type, form and style and lacks the architectural distinctiveness necessary to qualify it for listing on the National Register of Historic Places.


