2. end and between each bay. Window and door frames are the plan cheek type with wide lintels capped by ogee moulding. Across the street facade is a one-story porch supported by plain square wood posts. The porch has a balustrade of banjo boards in two different styles. All windows are two over two across the front facade and six over six on the back where each unit has a one-story lean-to or flounder. These sheds or flounders could be removed or raised a full two stories without adversely affecting the building's appearance on the street.

3. and scale of this National Historic Landmark district. The street facade with its long porch extending across the entire facade and handsome balustrade of banjo boards (few of banjo's board balustrades have survived in Annapolis) is particularly pleasing and distinctive offering visual relief from the monotony of the white brick Naval Academy wall across the street. The building's adaptation into residential units will help to insure the preservation of the block which is adjacent to four National Historic Landmarks, (the U.S. Naval Academy, the Wm. Paca House, the Brice House and the Hammond-Harwood House).


