5. Description of physical appearance:

The original structure is a 2 story frame building with attic approximately 15'X24' and full basement approximately 4' below grade. The foundation is stone masonry below grade and brick above. It has a gable roof now covered with asphalt shingles and the original wood siding has been covered with asbestos shingles. A two story addition to the rear, approximately 15'X12', is of similar construction with a metal shed roof, with brick foundation below grade and frame above. It has boxed cornice, central chimney at rear plane of roof, transom lit door and wood stoop. Interior walls and ceilings are original horsehair plaster on wood lath, except where repaired. Floors are hardwood on first floor over original softwood plank on the joists. Original softwood floors on second floor and attic. Woodwork is original dense pine, except for first floor to second floor stair rail.


6. Statement of significance:

The structure is one block from the Annapolis Market near historic structures including the Middleton Tavern, the Tobacco Prise and the Shiplap House and Museum. It is on the North West corner of "Ships Carpenter Lot" confirmed to Horatio Samuel in 1754. The structure may date from the early 19th Century and is possibly a dwelling mentioned in a 1841 deed. Based on Sandborn Maps, the addition to the rear of the original structure was added some time between 1897 and 1903. According to the Architectural Survey of Historic Annapolis, Inc, the original structure is of "Minor Vernacular Annapolis Federal" style and "...has potential to become important as a type. Important to streetscape at alley through to Pinkney Street and the Market space." The building is similar in building materials, style, and period of construction, but smaller, than 149 Prince George Street to the South East and buildings to the North West on the same side of the street up to East street.
