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ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL OR STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

Patterned shingle Mansard with two pedimented dormers, stepped curb, overhanging cornice with sawn end consoles; excellent window caps with semi-circular tops inscribed with punched decorations, molded caps; pedimented door cap with similar treatment and finial, transom light and later well designed stoop. Area between 181 and 183 infilled with two bay addition, with the cornice of 183 extended.






